CAMP is excited to bring this one day training to San Antonio. This event is recommended for parents, CAMP counselors and staff, teachers, nurses, therapists, personal care attendants, case managers, foster parents, and others who care for or provide services to individuals with special needs.

### Training Sessions:

- 8:00am – 1pm (registration begins at 7:30am)
  - Nonviolent Crisis Intervention (CPI), presented by Brandon G. Briery, Ph.D. – This session offers insight on how to deal with negative behavior and prevent escalation to crisis mode. There is a \$15 charge for the official book, test materials, and certificate, which many professionals need. If you would like to audit the session there is no charge, but book and other materials will not be provided.
- 8:30-10:30am (registration begins at 8:00am)
  - Working with Families of Children with Special Needs, presented by Judy Foster BSN RN. This session includes the poem *Welcome to Holland*, and gives insights on how to successfully team with families to provide care or services.
  - Introduction to CAMP, presented by Ben Elble, Associate Camp Director. Do you have a teenager, 14 and older, who would benefit from volunteering at CAMP? Would you like more information about sending your child with special needs to summer CAMP? This session will give an overview of the program and will allow time for questions and answers.
- 10:45am-12:45pm
  - Working with Individuals with Special Needs, presented by Ben Elble and Judy Foster. This session will cover several areas of concern that parents of, and those with, special needs have determined is important for caregivers, service providers and other professionals to know. We will discuss many topics, including communication, health, hygiene, sexual development, and more.
  - Resources for the Individual with Special Needs, presented by Rita DeVine and Janie Sarabia. We at CAMP often talk with parents who are not aware of the many government programs that would benefit their child, how to get them placed on waiting lists, and how important it is to start this process early. This session will give an overview of many of these programs and tell you where to go for more assistance.
- 1:30pm-5:00pm
  - Dr. Chris Plauche (Johnson), one of the founders of CAMP and a nationally renowned speaker, often presents at our educational seminars for medical professionals, and we wanted to make this excellent and much needed information available to our parents, counselors, and other professionals. She will be presenting on Autism/PDD, Mental Retardation (Intellectual Disability), and Cerebral Palsy.
