



## Bexar MRA In-Home and Family Support

- In-Home and Family Support Program provides up to \$2500 in funds to individuals who have a documented diagnosis of Mental Retardation, Pervasive Developmental Disorder / Autism, or Developmental Delay.**
- ❖ **Supervision 13+ (Service for individuals over the age of 13)** - Provides for supervision of a child age 13 years or older who may not be left alone. The individual providing the supervision needs no specialized training or assistance. This service can be used daily.
  - ❖ **Respite In-Home or Out-of Home-** An occasional break for the caregiver and person with the disability. Respite can be used in or out of the home, to include Camp C.A.M.P.
  - ❖ **Non-durable or disposable goods-** Non-durable medical supplies, such as diapers, feeding tubes, etc. Requires a physician's prescription order.
  - ❖ **Personal Assistant-** Individual to assist the person with daily living needs. May include bathing, grooming, dressing, eating, etc.
  - ❖ **Therapies-** Physical, Speech, Occupational, ABA, and other Therapies related to addressing the person's functioning, communication, or behaviors. Requires a recommendation from a Licensed Therapist following an evaluation from a physician. School age persons may require additional recommendations from the school therapist.
  - ❖ **IHFS may also be able to provide assistance funding:** dental, adaptive aids, mobility equipment, therapy equipment, architectural modifications, public transportation, and co-pays.

\* IHFS is a funding source of last resort and all other services must be explored prior to eligibility. Families choose the providers and vendors. Providers must be 18 years or older and not residing in the family's home.
