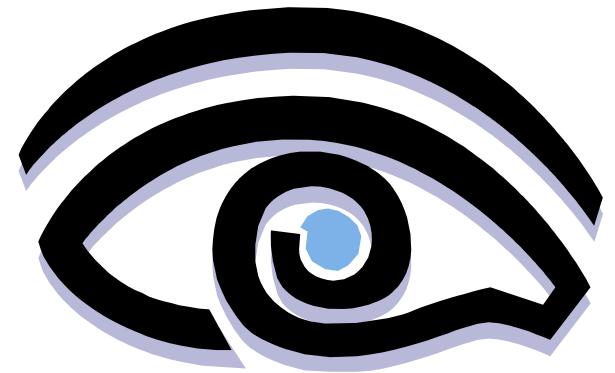
Mission:
