The Texas Department of Aging and Disability Services (DADS) will hold a series of town hall meetings across the state to provide an opportunity for individuals, service providers and the general public to learn more about the Consumer Directed Services (CDS) service delivery option available in many DADS programs.

If you choose the Consumer Directed Services option, you or your designated representative will:

- Recruit, hire and train your own employees and backup employees (including family, friends or neighbors)
- Set wages and benefits for your employees based on a service budget created with the help of your service planning team
- Set schedules and submit timesheets for your employees
- Select a Consumer Directed Services agency to
 - Process your timesheets and payroll
 - Process receipts and invoices
 - Act as your agent to pay federal and state employment taxes
